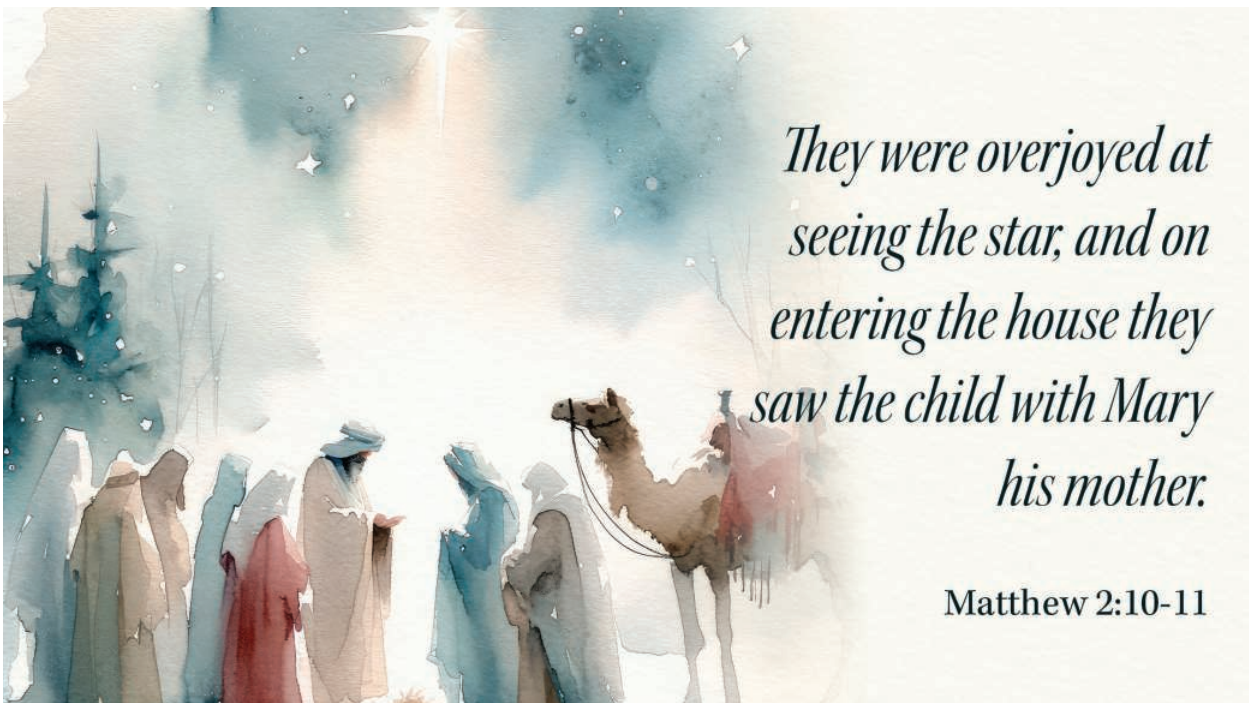

PASTOR'S NOTES

Merry Christmas! Yes, we are still in the Christmas season 😊 Today the Church celebrates the Epiphany of our Lord! (In the U.S. we celebrate Epiphany on the Sunday between Jan. 2 and Jan. 8.) The word, epiphany, means manifestation. Jesus is revealed as the "light of the nations." We hear in the Gospel, "magi from the East seek to do him homage." This scene in the Gospel reveals that the message of Jesus extends to all people of the earth. Jesus' salvation is for everyone. This day has a rich tradition in many cultures. In many Hispanic communities, Epiphany is also known as Tres Reyes (3 Kings). Just as the magi brought gifts to Jesus, this is also a day that families exchange gifts. There is also a tradition where families bless their homes with chalk and the letters written on the door mantel: 20+C+B+M+22. The numbers are the year and the letters symbolize the traditional names of the 3 magi - Caspar, Balthazar and Melchior. It also refers to a Latin phrase *Christus Mansionem Benedicat* which means "Christ bless this house."

With the feast of Epiphany, we continue to celebrate the birth of Christ and his entrance into the world. Jesus is the Prince of Peace. He is the source of authentic joy and peace. As we begin 2025, we remind ourselves why our parishes exist: *St. Anthony and Our Lady of Mercy exist to create a community where people experience healing and joy that comes from a loving relationship with Jesus Christ. May Jesus be the center of our life. We pray that He may bring us his light in the dark moments of our lives. We pray that he may continue to bless our parish family abundantly.*

¡Feliz Navidad! Sí, todavía estamos en Navidad 🌟 ¡Hoy la Iglesia celebra la Epifanía de Nuestro Señor! (En Estados Unidos celebramos la Epifanía el domingo entre el 2 y el 8 de enero.) La palabra, epifanía, significa manifestación. Jesús se revela como la «luz de las naciones». Escuchamos en el Evangelio: «los magos de Oriente buscan rendirle homenaje». Esta escena del Evangelio revela que el mensaje de Jesús se extiende a todos los pueblos de la tierra. La salvación de Jesús es para todos. Este día tiene una rica tradición en muchas culturas. En muchas comunidades hispanas, la Epifanía se conoce también como Tres Reyes. Al igual que los Reyes Magos llevaron regalos a Jesús, éste es también un día en el que las familias intercambian regalos. También hay una tradición en la que las familias bendicen sus casas con tiza y las letras escritas en la repisa de la puerta: 20+C+B+M+22. Los números son el año y las letras simbolizan los nombres tradicionales de los 3 reyes magos: Caspar, Baltasar y Melchor. También hace referencia a una frase latina Christus Mansionem Benedicat que significa «Cristo bendiga esta casa».
