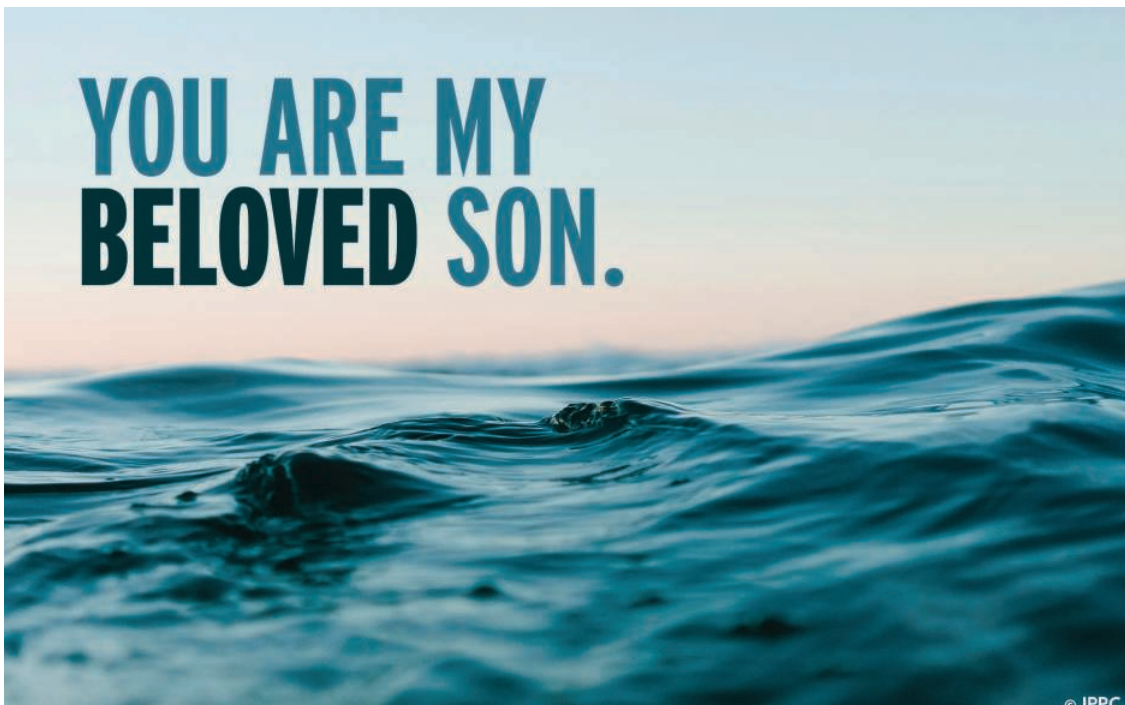

PASTOR'S NOTES

The celebration of the Baptism of Jesus serves as a transition from the close of the Christmas Season to the beginning of Ordinary Time. The Gospel of Luke tells us, *"the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove and a voice from heaven was heard, 'You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.'"* The Baptism of Jesus reinforces Jesus' identity and begins his public ministry.

For us, we reflect on our own Baptism. At our Baptism, we are given an identity. We, too, are beloved daughters and sons. We are "adopted" into the family of God. We call God our Father, Jesus, our older brother, and Mary, our Mother. In our Baptism, we too are filled with the Holy Spirit. In that sense, we too begin our public ministry.

This year, the Church celebrates a Jubilee Year, **Pilgrims of Hope**. Pope Francis tells us, "the word 'pilgrim' makes us think about walking... But the 'pilgrim' is one who not only walks, but has a destination, and a particular destination," which is "a holy place, which attracts him, which motivates the journey, which sustains him in his fatigue... we are pilgrims on the move... eager to meet Jesus, to know him, to listen to his word."

The Lord's word, the pope said, gives meaning to life and "fills it with a new joy, a different joy, a joy that does not remain 'outside' on the surface, but which fills the heart and warms it, a joy that is peace, that is goodness, that is tenderness."

This year, let us be pilgrims of hope. Jesus is the hope for every man and woman and also for the world. "Let us follow this road, and we too will become little signs of hope for those we meet."

ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

La celebración del Bautismo de Jesús sirve de transición entre el final del tiempo de Navidad y el comienzo del tiempo ordinario. El Evangelio de Lucas nos dice: «*el Espíritu Santo bajó sobre él en forma sensible, como de una paloma, y del cielo llegó una voz que decía: «Tú eres mi Hijo, el predilecto; en ti me complazco»*». El Bautismo de Jesús refuerza su identidad e inicia su ministerio público.

Para nosotros, reflexionamos sobre nuestro propio Bautismo. En nuestro Bautismo, se nos da una identidad. También nosotros somos hijos e hijas amados. Somos «adoptados» en la familia de Dios. Llamamos a Dios nuestro Padre, a Jesús, nuestro hermano mayor, y a María, nuestra Madre. En nuestro Bautismo, también nosotros estamos llenos del Espíritu Santo. En ese sentido, también nosotros comenzamos nuestro ministerio público.

Este año, la Iglesia celebra un Año Jubilar, **Peregrinos de la Esperanza**. El Papa Francisco nos dice: «la palabra “peregrino” nos hace pensar en caminar... Pero el “peregrino” es aquel que no sólo camina, sino que tiene un destino, y un destino particular», que es «un lugar santo, que lo atrae, que motiva el camino, que lo sostiene en su fatiga... somos peregrinos en camino... deseosos de encontrar a Jesús, de conocerlo, de escuchar su palabra».

La palabra del Señor, dijo el Papa, da sentido a la vida y «la llena de una alegría nueva, una alegría distinta, una alegría que no se queda “fuera” en la superficie, sino que llena el corazón y lo calienta, una alegría que es paz, que es bondad, que es ternura».

Este año, seamos peregrinos de esperanza. Jesús es la esperanza para todo hombre y también para el mundo. «Sigamos este camino, y también nosotros nos convertiremos en pequeños signos de esperanza para los que encontremos».
