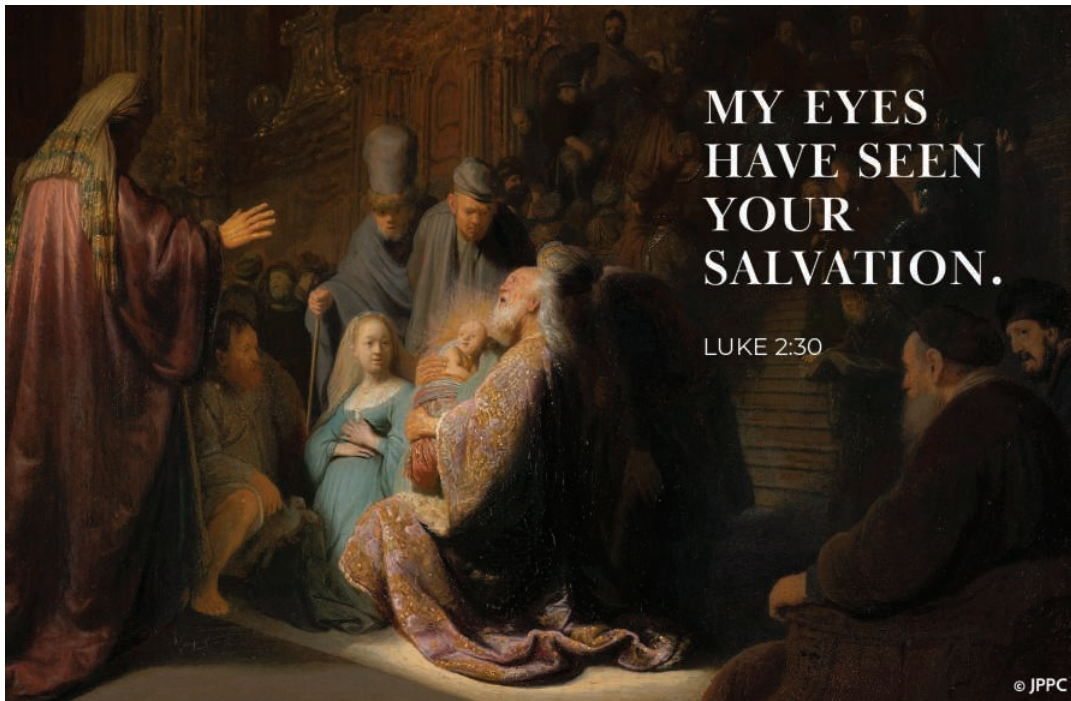

PASTOR'S NOTES

Can you believe that we are in February already? Feb. 2 is the feast of the Presentation of our Lord and it takes precedence over the 4th Sunday of Ordinary Time. In the Gospel, we hear the prophet Simeon pray over the 40 day old baby Jesus. Jesus is the salvation of the world. He is a light to all nations. Over 2000 years later, we look to Jesus to illuminate our life and guide our steps. Jesus must be the center of our lives. That is what makes us Catholic Christians. You have heard it before, "Our Lady of Mercy and St. Anthony exist to create a community where people experience healing and joy which comes from a loving relationship with Jesus Christ." Do you experience joy and healing as members of our parish community? How have you grown in your relationship with Jesus Christ? These are important questions to reflect upon. We have been working to align our parish activities with a common vision.

Our Parish Vision for 2025 is here! After months of work by our Envisioning Team, we're excited to share the pastoral plan for St. Anthony and Our Lady of Mercy. The Parish Vision outlines 3 major priorities for our parishes. Priority 1 is **Welcoming & Hospitality**. Priority 2 is **Confidence in Teaching the Faith**, and Priority 3 is **Growing in Discipleship**. Pick up a copy at church or visit www.rccofeaston.org

If you recall, last year you may have participated in the DMI, the Disciple Maker Index survey. Here is a little history: The survey closed at Easter last year. The data was compiled and the results were sent to the parishes. In August, I gathered a team of 10 people from our parish communities. This Envisioning Team met over the months of September - December to prepare a 3 year pastoral plan. Guided by the data from the survey and drawing from the experience of the Envisioning Team, we discerned 3 priorities for our parish. Under each priority, we developed 2 SMART goals. And under each goal, we have listed strategies to accomplish these goals.

Over the next 2 months, I will introduce our Parish Vision via homilies and the bulletin. I invite you to reflect on the Parish Vision. Is there an area that interests you? Where might God be gently nudging you to participate? I am looking for volunteers who would like to participate in our Implementation Team.

I am excited as we begin this new adventure.

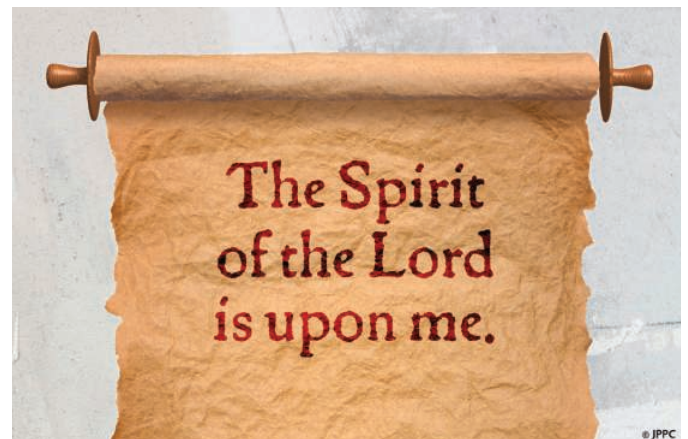
