PASTOR'S NOTES

I would like to share with you a reflection by Pope Francis on this Sunday's gospel:

"In this time of Lent we are preparing for the celebration of Easter, when we will renew the promises of our Baptism. Let us travel in the world as Jesus did, and let us make our whole existence a sign of our love for our brothers, especially the weakest and poorest, let us build for God a temple of our lives. And so we make it "encounterable" for those who we find along our journey. If we are witnesses of this living Christ, so many people will encounter Jesus in us, in our witness. But, we ask – and each one of us can ask ourselves – does the Lord feel at home in my life? Do we allow Him to "cleanse" our hearts and to drive out the idols, those attitudes of cupidity, jealousy, worldliness, envy, hatred, those habits of gossiping and tearing down others. Do I allow Him to cleanse all the behaviours that are against God, against our neighbour, and against ourselves, as we heard today in the first Reading? Each one can answer for himself, in the silence of his heart: "Do I allow Jesus to make my heart a little cleaner?" "Oh Father, I fear the rod!" But Jesus never strikes. Jesus cleanses with tenderness, with mercy, with love. Mercy is the His way of cleansing. Let us, each of us, let us allow the Lord to enter with His mercy – not with the whip, no, with His mercy – to cleanse our hearts. The whip of Jesus with us is His mercy. Let us open to Him the gates so that He would make us a little cleaner."

Every Eucharist that we celebrate with faith makes us grow as a living temple of the Lord, thanks to the communion with His crucified and risen Body. Jesus recognizes that which is in each of us, and knows well our most ardent desires: that of being inhabited by Him, only by Him. Let us allow Him to enter into our lives, into our families, into our hearts. May Mary most holy, the privileged dwelling place of the Son of God, accompany us and sustain us on the Lenten journey, so that we might be able to rediscover the beauty of the encounter with Christ, the only One Who frees us and saves us."

COMUNIDAD HISPANA

ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

Me gustaría compartir con ustedes una reflexión del Papa Francisco sobre el Evangelio de este domingo:

"En este tiempo de Cuaresma nos preparamos para la celebración de la Pascua, en la que renovaremos las promesas de nuestro Bautismo. Viajemos por el mundo como Jesús, y hagamos de toda nuestra existencia un signo de nuestro amor a los hermanos, especialmente a los más débiles y pobres, construyamos para Dios un templo de nuestra vida. Y así lo hagamos "encontrable" para quienes encontremos en nuestro camino. Si somos testigos de este Cristo vivo, muchas personas encontrarán a Jesús en nosotros, en nuestro testimonio. Pero, nos preguntamos -y cada uno de nosotros puede preguntarse-, ¿se sienten el Señor a gusto en mi vida? ¿Permitimos que Él "limpie" nuestros corazones y expulse los ídolos, esas actitudes de codicia, celos, mundanidad, envidia, odio, esos hábitos de chismorrear y despreciar a los demás? ¿Dejo que limpie todos los comportamientos que van contra Dios, contra el prójimo y contra nosotros mismos, como hemos escuchado hoy en la primera lectura? Cada uno puede responder por sí mismo, en el silencio de su corazón: "¿Permito que Jesús limpie un poco mi corazón?". "¡Oh Padre, temo la vara!". Pero Jesús nunca golpea. Jesús limpia con ternura, con misericordia, con amor. La misericordia es su manera de limpiar. Dejemos, cada uno de nosotros, dejemos que el Señor entre con Su misericordia -no con el látigo, no, con Su misericordia- para limpiar nuestros corazones. El látigo de Jesús con nosotros es Su misericordia. Abrámsle las puertas para que nos haga un poco más limpios.

Cada Eucaristía que celebramos con fe nos hace crecer como templo vivo del Señor, gracias a la comunión con su Cuerpo crucificado y resucitado. Jesús reconoce lo que hay en cada uno de nosotros, y conoce bien nuestros deseos más ardientes: el de ser habitados por Él, sólo por Él. Dejámsle entrar en nuestras vidas, en nuestras familias, en nuestros corazones. Que María santísima, morada privilegiada del Hijo de Dios, nos acompañe y sostenga en el camino cuaresmal, para que seamos capaces de redescubrir la belleza del encuentro con Cristo, el único que nos libera y nos salva".
