PASTOR'S NOTES

Holy Week is upon us. We have been preparing for this week through prayer, fasting and works of charity. We are preparing to celebrate more deeply the Paschal Mystery. The passion, death and resurrection of Jesus is the central mystery of our Catholic Faith. The power of the cross which leads to a transformation – eternal life. Jesus Christ takes on the Sin, suffering and Death of the entire world. Jesus puts to death, Sin, suffering and Death itself on the cross. His Resurrection reveals the triumph and abundant life available to us. Jesus is not dead but he is alive. Through the gift of supernatural faith and the power of the Sacraments, we receive supernatural life which heals us from the wounds caused by sin. Holy Week commemorates these central events in the beautiful liturgies which we will celebrate. Passion Sunday we celebrate the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem with the waving of palms. Yet, the liturgy ends with the betrayal and crucifixion of Jesus Christ. Holy Thursday we celebrate the institution of the Holy Eucharist and the Priesthood. Good Friday, we accompany Jesus in his passion and death. Saturday is a day of silence as we wait. That evening we celebrate the Easter Vigil at 8pm. This beautiful liturgy begins in complete darkness and bursts into light and life as we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ. These events recall and represent the most beautiful love story. The Father sends his Son to rescue fallen and wounded humanity.

That wounded fallen humanity is you and me. Jesus comes to rescue us, to heal us, to save us and to accompany us through life leading us home to heaven.

I invite you to join us for these beautiful liturgies. This year, Holy Thursday, will be at OLOM and the Saturday Easter Vigil will be at St. Anthony. Good Friday in English will be at St. Anthony and in Spanish at OLOM beginning at 3pm. Also, Good Friday at 7pm will be a meditative Stations of the Cross at OLOM at 7pm.

As we conclude our Lenten journey, if you haven't had the opportunity, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available on Monday, March 25 at 7pm at OLOM and Tuesday, March 26 from 3-5 pm at St. Anthony. Also, St. Jane will have confessions on Wednesday, March 27 at 7pm.

We will be praying for you and your families as we enter into the holiest time of the year!

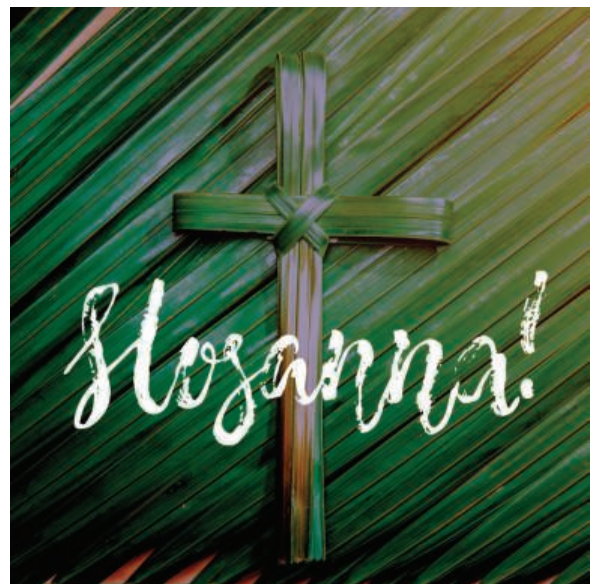

Esa humanidad herida y caída somos tú y yo. Jesús viene a rescatarnos, a curarnos, a salvarnos y a acompañarnos por la vida llevándonos a casa, al cielo.
