PASTOR'S NOTES

Traditionally, the 4th Sunday of Easter is known as Good Shepherd Sunday because the Gospel is taken from a portion of John 10. Jesus says, "I am the good shepherd. A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." Jesus sacrificial love for each of us is on display every time we reflect upon a crucifix. Jesus encourages us to imitate his love. I am reminded of Blessed Stanley Rother, the Oklahoma priest, who was martyred in Guatemala on July 28, 1981. While serving as pastor in Santiago Atitlan, his life was threatened by a government death squad. After a brief period away from his parish, he returned to be with his people. He said, "A shepherd cannot abandon his sheep at the first sign of danger." His return and presence gave courage to his parish flock. In imitation of Jesus Christ, he too offered his life out of love for his people. There is a saying in the Church, "the blood of the martyrs is the seed of the Church." In his parish which had been founded in 1547, there had been no vocations to the priesthood. Since 1981, there have been 9 priests and currently 7 seminarians. This is one sign of the fruitfulness of Fr. Rother's sacrifice. I encourage you to read **The Shepherd Who Didn't Run** by Maria Ruiz Scaperlanda.

The Church continues to call young men and women to consecrate their life in service to God's people. This summer, our diocese hosts a wonderful opportunity, Quo Vadis, for young men or Fiat days for young women. This is a week in the summer filled with activities to help explore the possibility of a vocation in the Church. Have you encouraged anyone to consider the possibility of serving as a priest or a religious sister or brother? Let us pray to the Good Shepherd that he may assist a young man or a young women to consecrate their life out of love to serve God's people.

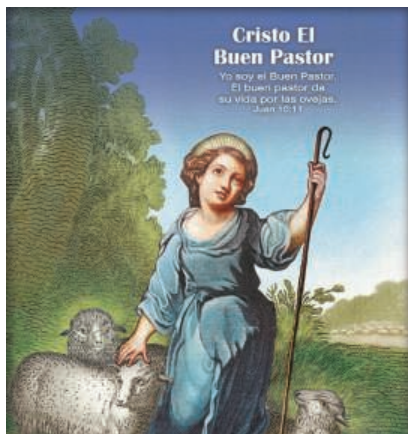
COMUNIDAD HISPANA

ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

Tradicionalmente, el 4º domingo de Pascua se conoce como el Domingo del Buen Pastor porque el Evangelio está tomado de una parte de Juan 10. Jesús dice: "Yo soy el buen pastor. El buen pastor da su vida por las ovejas". El amor sacrificado de Jesús por cada uno de nosotros se muestra cada vez que reflexionamos sobre un crucifijo. Jesús nos anima a imitar su amor. Recuerdo al Beato Stanley Rother, sacerdote de Oklahoma, martirizado en Guatemala el 28 de julio de 1981. Mientras servía como párroco en Santiago Atitlán, su vida fue amenazada por un escuadrón de la muerte del gobierno. Tras un breve periodo alejado de su parroquia, regresó para estar con su gente. Decía: "Un pastor no puede abandonar a sus ovejas a la primera señal de peligro". Su regreso y su presencia infundieron valor al rebaño de su parroquia. A imitación de Jesucristo, también él ofreció su vida por amor a su pueblo. Hay un dicho en la Iglesia: "la sangre de los mártires es la semilla de la Iglesia". En su parroquia, fundada en 1547, no había habido vocaciones sacerdotales. Desde 1981, ha habido 9 sacerdotes y actualmente 7 seminaristas. Este es un signo de la fecundidad del sacrificio del P. Rother. Les animo a leer **El Pastor Que No Huyó**, de María Ruiz Escaperlanda.

La Iglesia sigue llamando a los jóvenes de ambos sexos a consagrar su vida al servicio del pueblo de Dios. Este verano, nuestra diócesis ofrece una magnífica oportunidad, Quo Vadis, para los jóvenes y Fiat Days para las jóvenes. Se trata de una semana de verano llena de actividades para ayudar a explorar la posibilidad de una vocación en la Iglesia. ¿Has animado a alguien a considerar la posibilidad de ser sacerdote o religioso?
