PASTOR'S NOTES

“On the day of Pentecost when the seven weeks of Easter had come to an end, Christ's Passover is fulfilled in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, manifested, given, and communicated as a divine person: of his fullness, Christ, the Lord, pours out the Spirit in abundance”(731). These words from the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) summarize the events we read about in the Acts of the Apostles today. There was a “noise like a driving wind” and “tongues of fire which rested on each of them.” The crowds which spoke different languages were able to understand the apostles preaching. The Holy Spirit was poured into the world. It animated the disciples of Jesus to boldly proclaim with courage and power the message of the Gospel. This message is destined for all people.

In the Gospel, we see the principal power of the Holy Spirit is the forgiveness of sin. The CCC reminds us, “Because we are dead or at least wounded through sin, the first effect of the gift of love [the Holy Spirit] is the forgiveness of our sins. The communion of the Holy Spirit in the Church restores to the baptized the divine likeness lost through sin.” The Holy Spirit heals and restores. We experience the effects of the Holy Spirit through the Sacraments and prayerful reflection on the Word of God.

Lastly, St Paul reminds us, “the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.” If we live in the Spirit, these fruits will be seen in our life.

We have received the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Baptism and Confirmation. The Holy Spirit continues God's transformative work in the world through us. The Holy Spirit is activated through our commitment to daily prayer. Let us listen attentively to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.

May this prayer from the “breath of God” be the oxygen for our soul.

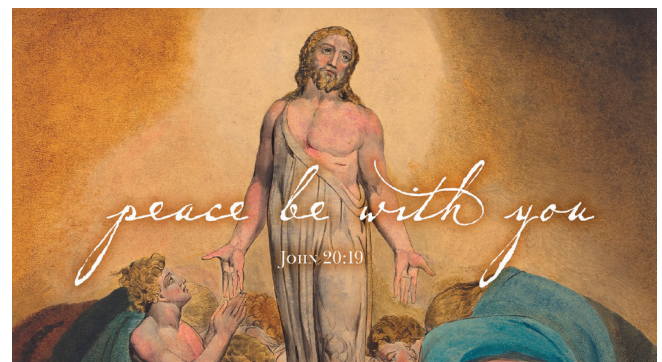

COMUNIDAD HISPANA

ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

"El día de Pentecostés, cuando habían concluido las siete semanas de Pascua, se cumple la Pascua de Cristo en la efusión del Espíritu Santo, manifestado, dado y comunicado como persona divina: de su plenitud, Cristo, el Señor, derrama el Espíritu en abundancia"(731). Estas palabras del Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (CIC) resumen los acontecimientos que leemos hoy en los Hechos de los Apóstoles. Había un «ruido como de viento impetuoso» y «lenguas de fuego que se posaban sobre cada uno de ellos». Las multitudes que hablaban diferentes lenguas pudieron entender la predicación de los apóstoles. El Espíritu Santo fue derramado en el mundo. Animó a los discípulos de Jesús a proclamar con valentía y poder el mensaje del Evangelio. Este mensaje está destinado a todos los hombres.

En el Evangelio, vemos que el principal poder del Espíritu Santo es el perdón de los pecados. El CIC nos recuerda: "Puesto que estamos muertos o al menos heridos por el pecado, el primer efecto del don del amor [el Espíritu Santo] es el perdón de nuestros pecados. La comunión del Espíritu Santo en la Iglesia devuelve a los bautizados la semejanza divina perdida por el pecado." El Espíritu Santo cura y restaura. Experimentamos los efectos del Espíritu Santo a través de los Sacramentos y de la reflexión orante sobre la Palabra de Dios.

Por último, San Pablo nos recuerda que "el fruto del Espíritu es amor, alegría, paz, paciencia, bondad, generosidad, fidelidad, mansedumbre, dominio de sí." Si vivimos en el Espíritu, estos frutos se verán en nuestra vida.

Hemos recibido el Espíritu Santo en el Sacramento del Bautismo y de la Confirmación. El Espíritu Santo continúa la obra transformadora de Dios en el mundo a través de nosotros. El Espíritu Santo se activa a través de nuestro compromiso con la oración diaria. Escuchemos atentamente la inspiración del Espíritu Santo.
