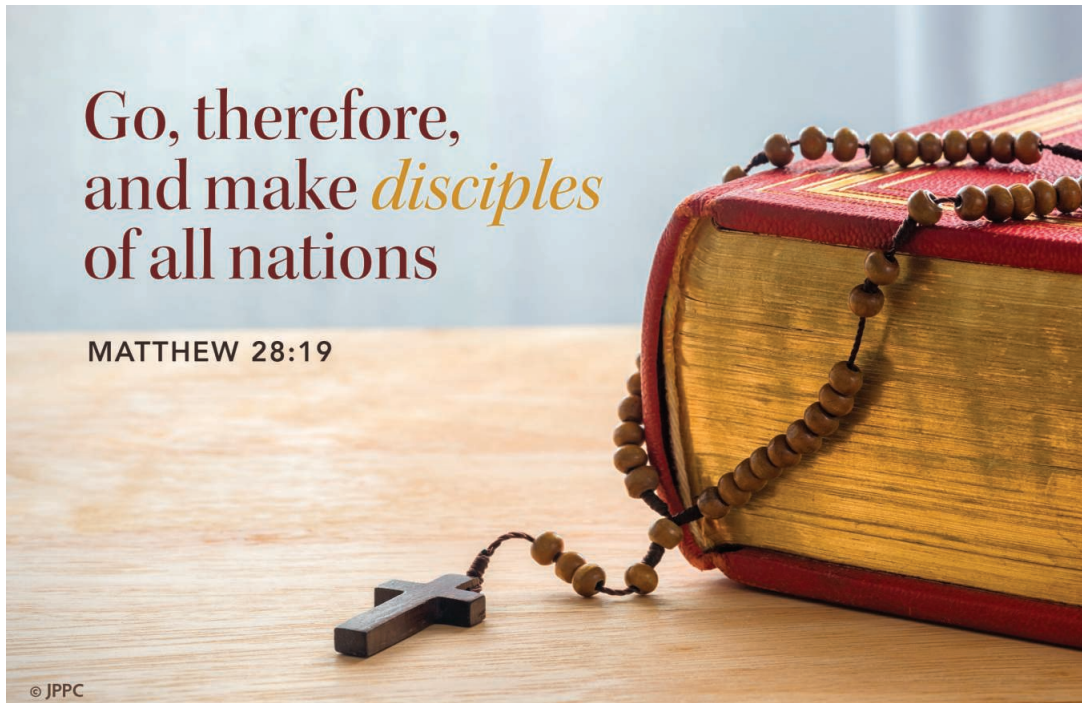

PASTOR'S NOTES

“Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations.” These words from the Gospel of Matthew are known as the Great Commission. They were spoken by Jesus to his disciples so they would continue his mission to all people. We have been blessed to have a missionary priest serve our community for the past 13 years. As a member of the Apostles of Jesus, Fr. Elias Munyaneza, responded to the call to dedicate his life to spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ. As the hospital chaplain at St. Luke Easton and St. Luke Anderson, he has dutifully cared for the sick and the dying. Father Elias has administered the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick and the Last Rites for the dying. He has heard confessions and has administered, Viaticum, food for the final journey. For 13 years, he has spiritually prepared many people to make their last journey to Heaven. Fr. Elias has assisted at many parishes and participated in the life of OLOM and St. Anthony.

As a resident at OLOM, I have lived in the same rectory with Fr. Elias for the last 10 years. We have shared many meals, had numerous conversations, played chess, and watched movies. I learned a lot about the history of Africa and the Apostles of Jesus, his religious community. I feel like he is an older brother to me. Fr. Elias’ assignment will be completed on Monday, June 17. He will be returning to his community, the Apostles of Jesus, for a new assignment in Nairobi, Kenya.

I would like to publicly offer sincere words of gratitude to Fr. Elias. Thank you for your generous service, your kindness, and your humility. Your love of God and his people show through in your words and your ministry. We are grateful for your missionary heart to leave your home in Africa to serve the people of the United States. Please know that you will always have a home here in Easton, PA.

Please keep Fr. Elias in your prayers as he prepares to end his assignment here and begin another phase of his vocation with the Apostles of Jesus. As we know from experience, change is never easy. But may we draw strength from the words of Jesus in today’s Gospel: “Behold, I am with you always.” May our Lord guide all of us through transitions and comfort us with His enduring presence.

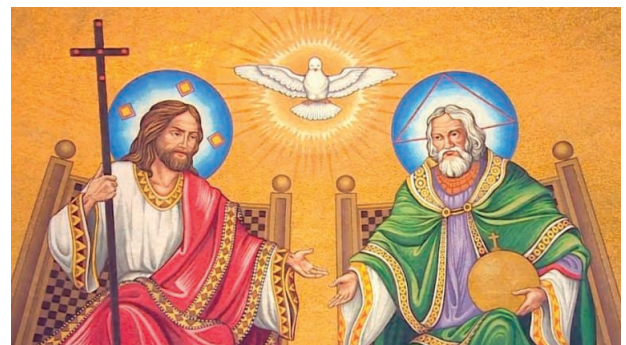

Hemos tenido la bendición de tener un sacerdote misionero sirviendo a nuestra comunidad durante los últimos 13 años. Como miembro de los Apóstoles de Jesús, el P. Elías Munyaneza, respondió a la llamada de dedicar su vida a difundir la Buena Nueva de Jesucristo. Como capellán de hospital en St. Luke Easton y St. Luke Anderson, ha atendido obedientemente a los enfermos y moribundos. El Padre Elías ha administrado el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos y la extremaunción a los moribundos. Ha escuchado confesiones y ha administrado el Viático, alimento para el viaje final.
