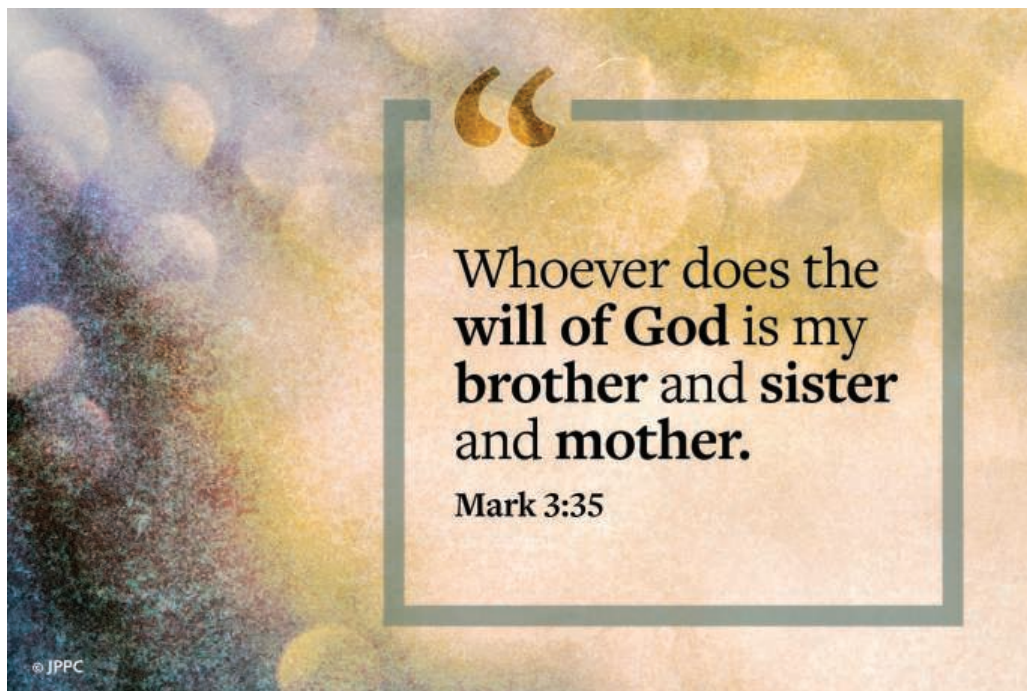

Our newly ordained, Fr. Miguel Ramierz, will be celebrating the 4:30pm at St. Anthony and 8:00am at OLOM. There will be a small reception after each of those Masses to congratulate him. He will also celebrate the 12 noon (Spanish) Mass, then join us at the Festa – Fiesta to offer his first blessing.

On Thursday, June 13 is the great feast of St. Anthony. We have a variety of activities this week. On Monday evening at St. Anthony Church at 6:30pm, local historian, Leonard Buscemi, will present a picture history of St. Anthony Church. Tuesday -Thursday we will have extended Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 8-12.
