PASTOR'S NOTES

We walk by faith and not by sight.

This wisdom from St. Paul from the second letter to the Corinthians gives us courage. He is reminding us that things don't always appear what they seem. We can look at a particular situation and it can appear hopeless. With the gift of supernatural Faith, we are able to look at the apparently hopeless situation with a deeper perspective. Our common experience of this occurs when we experience the death of a loved one. We feel the pain and sadness that come from losing a loved one, yet we are comforted by the promise of eternal life which comes to us from Jesus Christ. The gift of supernatural Faith lifts the veil of grief and shines hope in a very difficult moment of our lives. When we experience moments of loneliness or fear, we must acknowledge them and turn with confidence to God. The Faith tells us, "God is with us always (God does not abandon us)." When we unexpectedly lose a job or face a challenge in our family life, we are tempted to be discouraged and lose hope. These are real feelings we must acknowledge and talk to our Heavenly Father about our situation. The gift of supernatural Faith will reassure us that God does not reject us but will guide us through the painful experience.

When we look at the consecrated host during the Mass, the Faith informs us that this is not ordinary bread but rather the resurrected Jesus hidden under the appearance of bread. It is the sacrament of the Body of Christ. When St. Teresa of Calcutta would see a malnourished and dying person in the streets, she tells us that she sees Christ in that person.

We have all heard the expression, "Seeing is believing." This refers to the fact that seeing an object or evidence or proof confirms the belief in said object. My priest friend who happens to be legally blind doesn't like that saying. He prefers to say, "Believing is seeing." With the eyes of supernatural Faith, a whole new wonderful world opens to us.

Each morning, ask the Holy Spirit to increase the gift of supernatural Faith. Ask for the grace to look at the situations of your life with the eyes of Faith. Supernatural Faith changes our perspective on everything.

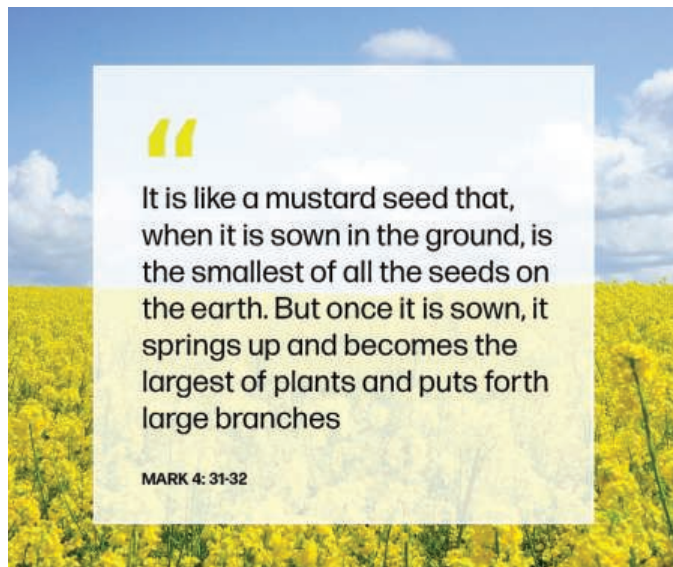

COMUNIDAD HISPANA

ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

Caminamos por la fe y no por la vista.

Esta sabiduría de San Pablo de la segunda carta a los Corintios nos infunde valor. Nos recuerda que las cosas no siempre son lo que parecen. Podemos ver una situación concreta y puede parecer desesperada. Con el don de la Fe sobrenatural, somos capaces de mirar la situación aparentemente sin esperanza con una perspectiva más profunda. Nuestra experiencia común de esto ocurre cuando experimentamos la muerte de un ser querido. Sentimos el dolor y la tristeza que conlleva la pérdida de un ser querido, pero nos reconforta la promesa de vida eterna que nos viene de Jesucristo. El don de la Fe sobrenatural levanta el velo del dolor y hace brillar la esperanza en un momento muy difícil de nuestras vidas. Cuando experimentamos momentos de soledad o miedo, debemos reconocerlos y dirigirnos con confianza a Dios. La Fe nos dice: «Dios está siempre con nosotros (Dios no nos abandona)». Cuando perdemos inesperadamente un trabajo o nos enfrentamos a un reto en nuestra vida familiar, tenemos la tentación de desanimarnos y perder la esperanza. Estos son sentimientos reales que debemos reconocer y hablar con nuestro Padre Celestial sobre nuestra situación. El don de la Fe sobrenatural nos asegurará que Dios no nos rechaza, sino que nos guiará a través de la dolorosa experiencia.

Cuando miramos la hostia consagrada durante la Misa, la Fe nos informa de que no se trata de pan ordinario, sino de Jesús resucitado oculto bajo la apariencia de pan. Es el sacramento del Cuerpo de Cristo. Cuando Santa Teresa de Calcuta veía por la calle a una persona desnutrida y moribunda, nos decía que veía a Cristo en ella.

Todos hemos oído la expresión: «Ver para creer». Se refiere al hecho de que ver un objeto o una evidencia o prueba confirma la creencia en dicho objeto. A mi amigo sacerdote, que resulta ser legalmente ciego, no le gusta ese dicho. Prefiere decir: «Crear es ver». Con los ojos de la Fe sobrenatural, se nos abre todo un mundo nuevo y maravilloso.

Cada mañana, pide al Espíritu Santo que aumente el don de la Fe sobrenatural. Pide la gracia de mirar las situaciones de tu vida con los ojos de la Fe. La Fe sobrenatural cambia nuestra perspectiva de todo.

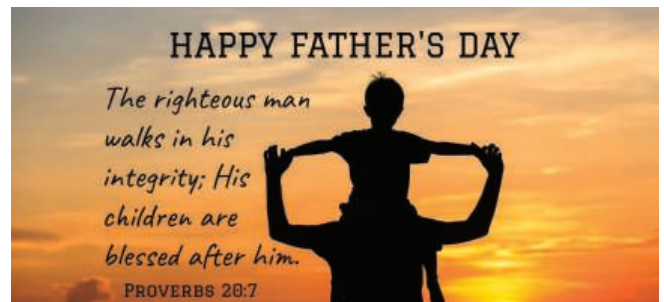
