PASTOR'S NOTES

Two of Jesus' apostles are named James. In the Scriptures, they are distinguished as James the Greater and James the Lesser. If you are a fan of The Chosen, they are referred to as Big James and Little James. Just like Jesus, we now have two James' as part of our parish community. I would like to officially welcome Fr. James Kanakulya and Fr. James Chalangadi, O.C.D.

Fr. Jim K arrived at the end of May for the ordination of Deacon Miguel. You may have seen Fr. Jim Kanakulya celebrating at one of the Masses on the weekend. Fr. Jim K. will be with us for the summer until September 2. As you recall, Fr. Jim K has been visiting Easton for the last 18 years. Fr. Jim K. is a professor at the Catholic University of East Africa located in Nairobi, Kenya. He is a diocesan priest from the Diocese of Jinja in Uganda.

Fr. Jim C. arrived this Tuesday at the parish. He will be the new chaplain at St. Luke Anderson and Easton campuses. He will be a resident at Our Lady of Mercy rectory. Fr. Jim C. has had a variety of assignments within the Diocese of Allentown. His previous assignment was a parochial vicar at St. Jane. The letters OCD stand for Order of the Discalced Carmelites. He was born in the state of Kerala, India.

While both of them speak multiple languages, they do not speak Spanish. You will see them at the English Masses. I am grateful for the presence of both Fr. Jims. They will enrich our community with their own experiences and love of God.

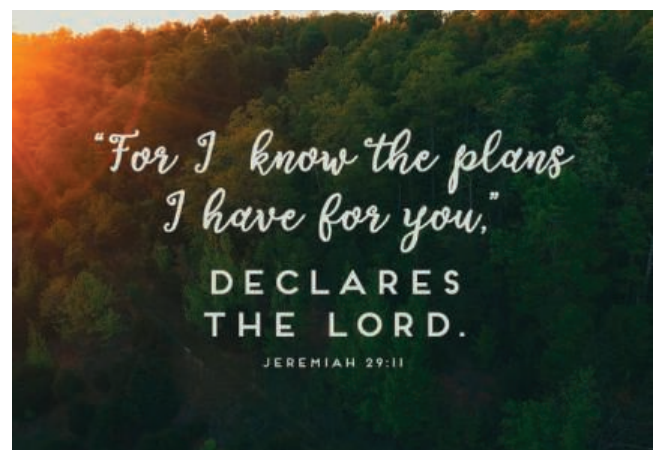
We are pleased to announce that we have received the date for Confirmation. Confirmation will be conferred on all prepared candidates on:

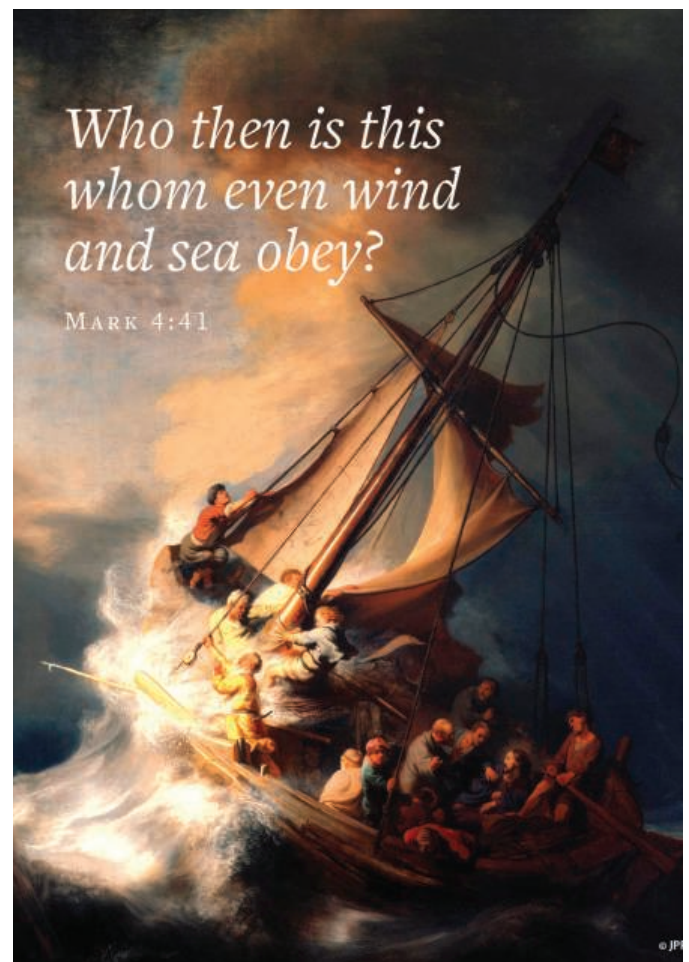
