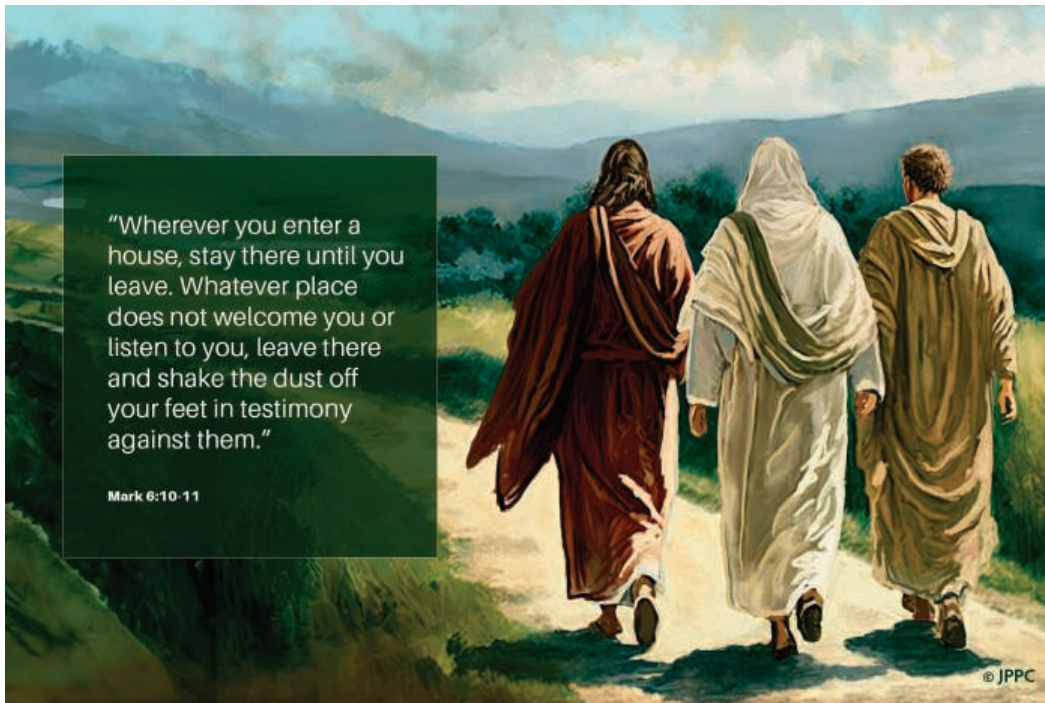

PASTOR'S NOTES

"They anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them." This passage from today's Gospel is recognized as part of the biblical basis for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. This is the only time in the Gospels that anointing with oil is mentioned in conjunction with curing the sick.

Do you remember how many sacraments there are? Just checking! Yes, there are 7 seven sacraments. These special gifts instituted by Christ and his Church enable us to experience his divine touch. The Sacraments of Initiation include Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. The Sacraments at the service of communion are directed toward the salvation of others. These include Holy Matrimony and Holy Orders. Finally, the Sacraments of Healing include Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick.

This last sacrament is sometime referred to as the "Last Rites" or perhaps many have heard it as the sacrament of Extreme Unction. The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us, "Anointing of the Sick is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death." It is for anyone who is "seriously ill." Before a serious operation and even those elderly experiencing their own frailty are invited to receive this sacrament.

In the Anointing of the Sick, Christ the physician, through the ministry of the priest, unites himself to the sick person. One of the graces of this sacrament is strengthening, peace and courage to overcome the difficulties that go with a serious illness. "Suffering... acquires a new meaning; it becomes a participation in the saving work of Jesus."

If there is an elderly or seriously ill individual family member or friend, please do not hesitate to contact the parish. We would be happy to make a visit.

Also, on Monday, July 29, we will have a special Mass with the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. It will be held at St. Anthony Church at 4:30pm. I extend an invitation to all who would like to participate in this Sacrament. Perhaps you have a neighbor who is unable to drive to Sunday Mass regularly because of age or health? Extend an invitation to bring them to Church. Jesus waits for them in a special way.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE arrangements should be made with the pastor one year prior to the wedding.

THE HOLY EUCHARIST is brought to the seriously ill and the aged monthly and Sundays by an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist, if requested.

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM is celebrated three times a year. Parents should be attending Mass regularly and are expected to attend a pre-baptism class. Sponsor certificates must be received by the Parish Center before the Baptism is scheduled. Please contact your respective parish.

ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

"Ungían con aceite a muchos enfermos y los curaban". Este pasaje del Evangelio de hoy es reconocido como parte de la base bíblica del Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos. Es la única vez en los Evangelios que se menciona la unción con aceite en relación con la curación de los enfermos.

¿Recuerdas cuántos sacramentos hay? Sí, hay 7 siete sacramentos. Estos dones especiales instituidos por Cristo y su Iglesia nos permiten experimentar su toque divino. Los Sacramentos de Iniciación incluyen el Bautismo, la Confirmación y la Sagrada Eucaristía. Los Sacramentos al servicio de la comunión están dirigidos a la salvación de los demás. Entre ellos están el Santo Matrimonio y el Santo Orden. Por último, los Sacramentos de curación incluyen la Reconciliación y la Unción de los Enfermos.

Este último sacramento se conoce a veces como la "extremaunción" o quizás muchos lo han oído como el sacramento de la Extremaunción. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica nos dice: "La Unción de los Enfermos no es un sacramento sólo para los que están a punto de morir". Es para cualquiera que esté "gravemente enfermo". Antes de una operación grave e incluso los ancianos que experimentan su propia fragilidad están invitados a recibir este sacramento.

En la Unción de los Enfermos, Cristo médico, a través del ministerio del sacerdote, se une al enfermo. Una de las gracias de este sacramento es el fortalecimiento, la paz y el valor para superar las dificultades que conlleva una enfermedad grave. "El sufrimiento... adquiere un nuevo significado; se convierte en participación en la obra salvadora de Jesús".

Si hay algún familiar o amigo anciano o gravemente enfermo, no dude en ponerse en contacto con la parroquia. Estaremos encantados de hacerle una visita.

Además, el lunes 29 de julio, tendremos una Misa especial con el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos. Tendrá lugar en la Iglesia de San Antonio a las 4:30pm. Extiende una invitación a todos los que quieran participar en este Sacramento. Tal vez usted tiene un vecino que no puede conducir a la Misa dominical con regularidad debido a la edad o la salud? Extienda una invitación para traerlos a Iglesia. Jesús les espera de una manera especial.
