PASTOR'S NOTES

The pastor returned from vacation and so did the Air Conditioning. 😊 The AC is finally working at Our Lady of Mercy. Due to the lightning storm on Wed. June 26, the compressor was “fried.” To replace the whole AC unit, we would have had to wait until the end of September. That would have meant the entire summer without AC. Instead, we decided to replace the compressor. A compressor can run over \$10,000. This is not an inexpensive job. With an AC that is close to 25 years old, it brings its own set of problems. The need to replace the Air Conditioner will be a decision that we have to face this next year. For the members of OLOM, I am asking for you to consider making a substantial contribution using our Capital Improvements envelope. These funds will help re-build our funds to cover the expenses for a future Air Conditioner.

At St. Anthony, the AC is working but it is not working at full capacity. We, too, at St. Anthony will be in need of replacing the AC in the Church. In addition, you have observed the scaffolding on the west side of the Church building. This is “phase 2” of the repointing of bricks, reglazing windows and other masonry repairs. This is a continuation of our previous work on ¾ of the East side of the building. This project is estimated at \$400,000.

I have written to our St. Anthony parishioners and sent a new envelope, Special Church Repair Fund. I am asking you to consider a substantial contribution to offset the expense of this necessary maintenance of the Church building.

We have been blessed by the generosity of previous generations. I am asking you to continue your generous financial support to cover these necessary expenses. With two sets of buildings to maintain, it can be a financial challenge. I want to thank my staff and volunteers who assist in these projects and offer me sage advice on how to address these needed repairs.

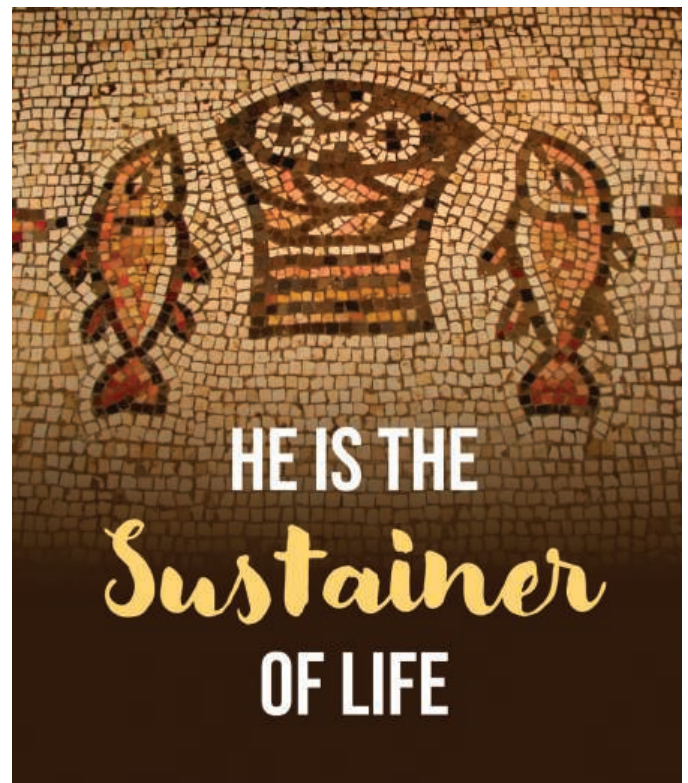

ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

El pastor regreso de sus vacaciones y tambien el aire acondicionado. 😊 El aire acondicionado finalmente esta funcionando en Nuestra Senora de la Misericordia. Debido a la tormenta eléctrica del mié. 26 de junio, el compresor estaba "frito." Para reemplazar toda la unidad de AC, habríamos tenido que esperar hasta finales de septiembre. Eso habría significado todo el verano sin aire acondicionado. En su lugar, decidimos sustituir el compresor. Un compresor puede costar más de 10.000 dólares. No es un trabajo barato. Con un AC que está cerca de 25 años de edad, trae su propio conjunto de problemas. La necesidad de reemplazar el Aire Acondicionado será una decisión que tendremos que enfrentar este próximo año. Para los miembros de OLOM, les pido que consideren hacer una contribución substancial usando nuestro sobre de Mejoras Captales. Estos fondos ayudaran a reconstruir nuestros fondos para cubrir los gastos de un futuro Aire Acondicionado.

En San Antonio, el aire acondicionado está funcionando, pero no funciona a plena capacidad. Nosotros, tambien, en San Antonio necesitaremos reemplazar el aire acondicionado en la Iglesia. Además, usted ha observado el andamio en el lado oeste del edificio de la Iglesia. Esta es la "fase 2" de la reparación de ladrillos, ventanas y otras reparaciones de mampostería. Esta es una continuación de nuestro trabajo anterior en ¾ del lado este del edificio. Este proyecto se estima en 400.000 dólares.

He escrito a nuestros feligreses de San Antonio y enviado un nuevo sobre, Fondo Especial para Reparaciones de la Iglesia. Les pido que consideren una contribución sustancial para compensar los gastos de este mantenimiento necesario del edificio de la Iglesia.

Hemos sido bendecidos por la generosidad de generaciones anteriores. Le pido que continúe con su generoso apoyo financiero para cubrir estos gastos necesarios. Con dos conjuntos de edificios que mantener, puede ser un desafío financiero.
