PASTOR'S NOTES

We welcome the Missionhurst-CICM representative, Fr Jim Fischler. He will celebrate and speak at all the Masses this weekend. The priests and brothers of the Congregation of the Immaculate Heart of Mary are dedicated to sharing the hope and comfort of the Gospel, while relieving the suffering of our poorest, most neglected brothers and sisters in Christ. There are 841 CICM priests and brothers serving in over 23 countries. One of their major initiatives is known as, MERCYWORKS, which raises funds and awareness for mission ministries around the world that are dramatically impacting the success, health, and prosperity of children in need. Some examples include St. Jean Bosco School in Haiti. Many families cannot afford the \$120 to send their child to school for a whole year. The Bethany Center in Guatemala offers pre and post natal care for expectant mothers. St. Charles Primary School in Malawi which serves 300+ students in grades 1-6, two-thirds of which are young girls.

These are a few examples of the successful initiatives of Missionhurst which positively impact the lives of real human beings, particularly children. Every year we have the Diocesan Annual Mission appeal. Through the Pontifical Mission Societies, our parishes are assigned a missionary to speak at all of Masses. There are over 22 different organizations speaking at all 78 parishes of our Diocese. This missionary visit provides an opportunity for us to know about their communities efforts to reach people with great need. We are made aware of the struggles of our brothers and sisters in Christ. We can offer our prayers for them. We can also support these missions financially. Your generous financial support extends to the ends of the world and serves God's people in a particular way through these faith filled communities. 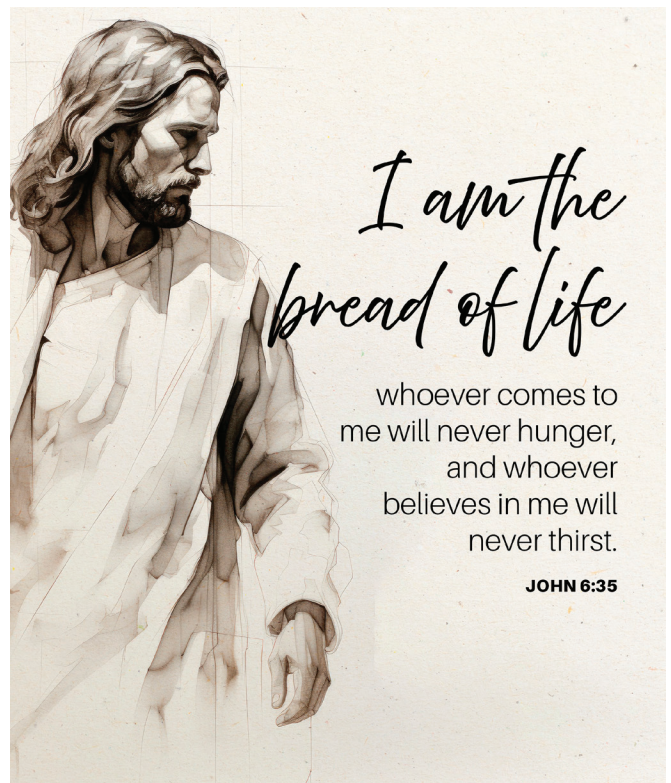

### EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL

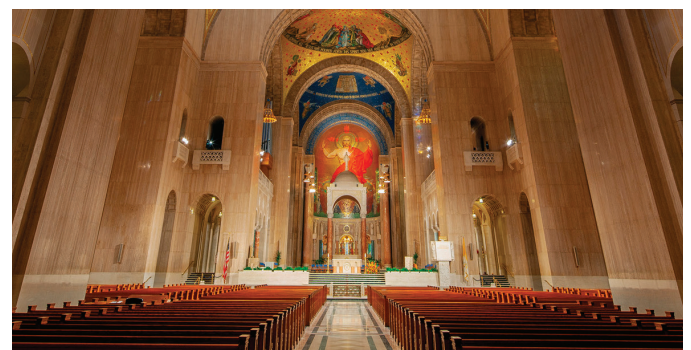
Nearly 60,000 Eucharistic Congress attendees were sent out with "a great commissioning." Keynote speakers urged participants to proclaim the Gospel in every corner of the country. More than 1,600 priests, seminarians, bishops and cardinals processed into Mass in the Indianapolis Colts' stadium in a dramatic opening procession lasting 25 minutes. An additional 1,236 religious sisters and brothers were praying in the stands, according to the event organizers. "Lord, we made a National Eucharistic Pilgrimage for you. For the last 65 days we brought your living presence across this land, across the East, West, North and South. We visited large churches and small churches. We had large processions in cities and small processions in prisons. We visited nursing homes and homeless shelters. Lord, we tried to share with everyone we met along the way your unspeakable love."
