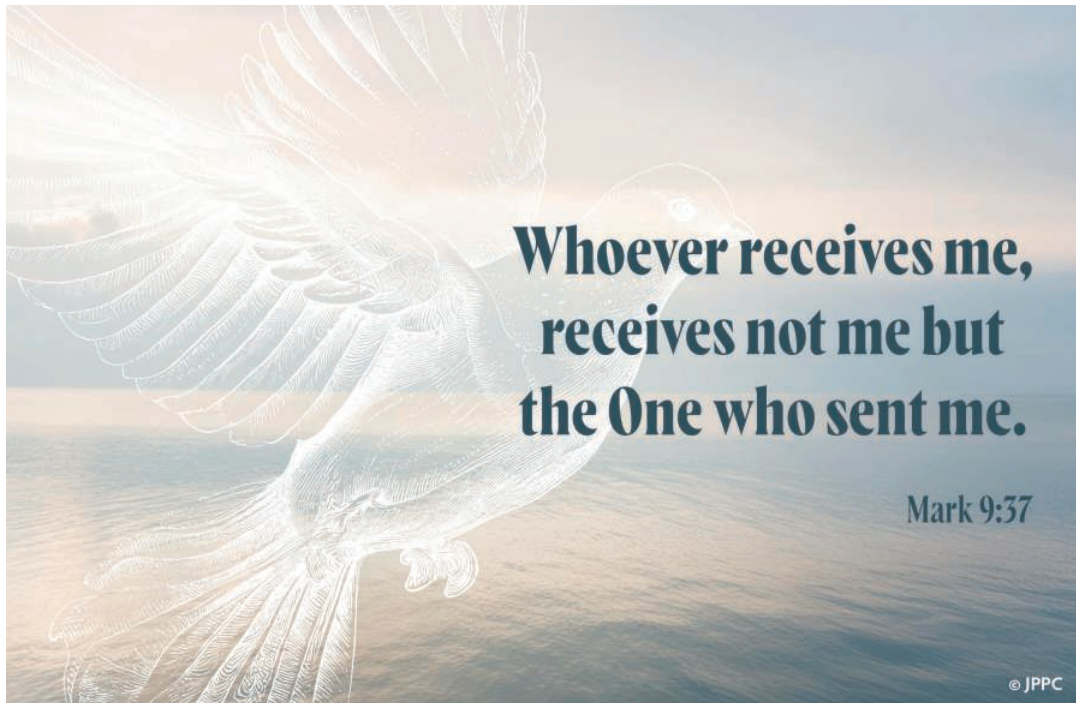

## PASTOR'S NOTES

Are you up for a challenge? I would like to invite you to participate in our first ever OCOTBER ROSARY CHALLENGE. In the Rosary, we pray with Mary as we reflect on the events of the life of her Son, Jesus Christ. The Biblical roots of the Rosary are found in the Gospel of Luke, "Mary pondered all these things in her heart." Throughout history, Mary has played a pivotal role in encouraging people to grow closer to her Son. October 7 is the feast of the Holy Rosary and October 13 is the feast of Our Lady of Fatima, which was the largest public miracle in modern times. Mary encourages us to pray the Rosary daily. Countless numbers of saints have encouraged us to pray the Rosary. Are you aware of the 15 promises the Blessed Mother gives to those who say the Rosary? Check it out!! 😊

Our Rosary Challenge will begin October 1. Praying the Rosary individually, or with your family or with a group of friends are all ways to pray this powerful prayer. Does anyone feel called to pray multiple mysteries each day? If you pray the Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful and Glorious mysteries in one day, that would count as 4 rosaries. If you have never prayed the rosary, would you be willing to start with one decade a day? That would be one rosary for the week. Anyone can participate. You can pray in Church, in your home, driving to work or before you go to bed. We simply ask that you include this intention in your Rosary prayer: For the protection and spiritual renewal of our parish family at St. Anthony and Our Lady of Mercy.

Each week, there will be a slip of paper where you can include the number of rosaries that you prayed that week. You can place that slip in the collection basket at Mass. There will be materials available to assist you in praying the Rosary. We also have online resources to guide your meditations.

Prayer is oxygen for the soul. I encourage you to participate in this prayer activity. Help us to reach our goal of 10,000 rosaries!!

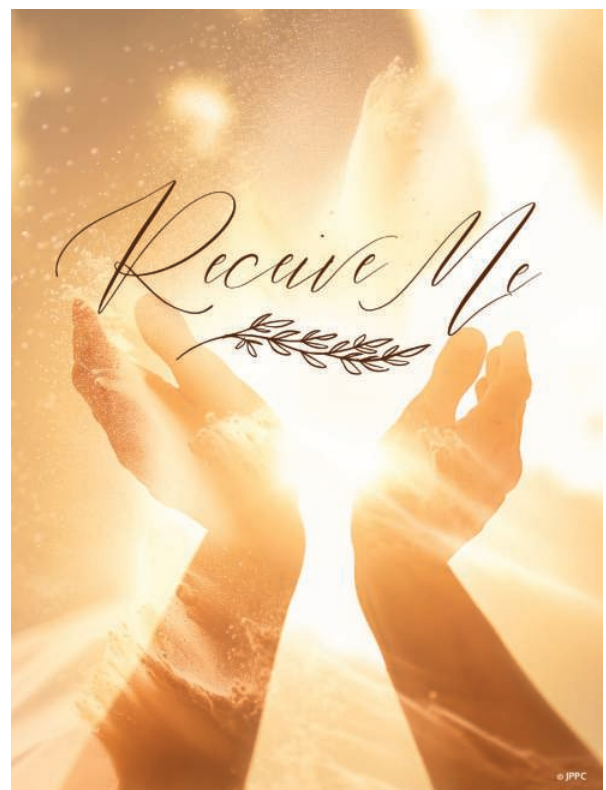
