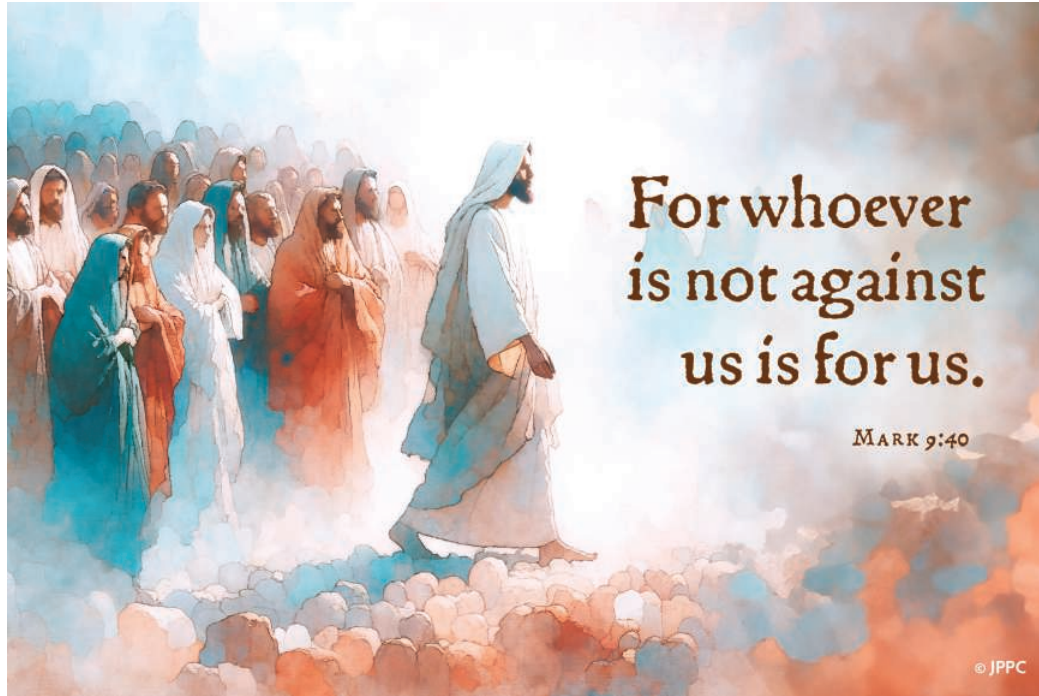

PASTOR'S NOTES

On Saturday, September 14, 2024, Bishop Schlert ordained 15 men as Permanent Deacons. In the Acts of the Apostles, chapter 6 describes the beginning of the ministry of deacon. Last year, we were assigned Deacon Miguel as a transitional deacon. Last June, he was ordained a priest. A permanent deacon is a man who receives the Sacrament of Holy Orders but will not receive the priesthood. Similar to a priest, a permanent deacon makes an application to the Bishop of the Allentown Diocese. If admitted, they have 6 years of formation. They are formed on the intellectual level by taking on-line classes at St. Bernards School of Theology and Ministry. They are formed spiritually by introduction to the Liturgy of the Hours and other forms of prayer. They commit to praying multiple times a day for the people of the Diocese of Allentown. They are formed pastorally through their various parish assignments over the summer and other opportunities to serve in ministry. Lastly, their human formation is a process where they are observed and evaluated each year. If they are making progress, they will continue. If there are difficulties, they will be given opportunities to make adjustments. Six years ago, I believe there were 40 applicants and 25 were selected and only 15 were ordained. The Ordination rite includes a Promise of Obedience, the Laying on of Hands, Investiture with deacon's vestments. Some of the tasks include: proclaiming the Gospel, delivering the homily, reading the intercessions, preparing the sacred vessels, assisting with the distribution with Holy Communion and announcing the Mass dismissal. He also serves by performing baptisms, officiating at simple marriage ceremonies, bringing viaticum to the dying, and conducting the Rite of Committal at the cemetery after a funeral Mass.

We have been assigned one of those permanent deacons. We welcome Deacon James Wallaesa and his wife Karen. They are parishioners of St. Jane Frances de Chantal. He will be a great blessing to our parish. Please welcome him and pray for him as he begins his first assignment with us.

COMUNIDAD HISPANA

ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

El sábado 14 de septiembre de 2024, el Obispo Schlert ordenó a 15 hombres como Diáconos Permanentes. En los Hechos de los Apóstoles, el capítulo 6 describe el comienzo del ministerio de diácono. El año pasado, se nos asignó al diácono Miguel como diácono transitorio. El pasado mes de junio, fue ordenado sacerdote. Un diácono permanente es un hombre que recibe el Sacramento del Orden, pero no recibirá el sacerdocio. Al igual que un sacerdote, un diácono permanente hace una solicitud al Obispo de la Diócesis de Allentown. Si son admitidos, tienen 6 años de formación. Se forman a nivel intelectual tomando clases en línea en la Escuela de Teología y Ministerio St. Bernards. Se forman espiritualmente mediante la introducción a la Liturgia de las Horas y otras formas de oración. Se comprometen a rezar varias veces al día por el pueblo de la Diócesis de Allentown. Se forman pastoralmente a través de sus diversas asignaciones parroquiales durante el verano y otras oportunidades para servir en el ministerio. Por último, su formación humana es un proceso en el que son observados y evaluados cada año. Si progresan, continúan. Si hay dificultades, se les dará la oportunidad de hacer ajustes. Hace seis años, creo que hubo 40 solicitantes y 25 fueron seleccionados y sólo 15 fueron ordenados. El rito de ordenación incluye una promesa de obediencia, la imposición de manos, la investidura con las vestiduras de diácono. Algunas de sus tareas son: proclamar el Evangelio, pronunciar la homilía, leer las intercesiones, preparar los vasos sagrados, ayudar en la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión y anunciar la salida de la Misa. También sirve realizando bautismos, oficiando ceremonias matrimoniales sencillas, llevando el viático a los moribundos y dirigiendo el Rito del Entierro en el cementerio después de una Misa funeral.

Se nos ha asignado uno de estos diáconos permanentes. Damos la bienvenida al diácono James Wallasea y a su esposa Karen. Son feligreses de Santa Juana Francisca de Chantal. Él será una gran bendición para nuestra parroquia. Por favor, denle la bienvenida y oren por Él mientras comienza su primera asignación con nosotros.
