PASTOR'S NOTES

On October 7, 1571, allied Christian forces of the Holy League won a decisive naval victory against superior invading Muslim forces of the Ottoman Empire in the celebrated Battle of Lepanto in the Gulf of Petras. This battle has been called "the battle that saved the West."

The Christian victory was attributed to the intercession of Our Lady, whose intervention was obtained through the praying of the rosary. Back in Rome, Pope Saint Pius V, [2] informed of the battle's happy outcome through mystical revelation, instituted October 7 as the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.

The development of the rosary has a long history. First, a practice arose of praying 150 Our Fathers in imitation of the 150 Psalms. Then there was a parallel practice of praying the Hail Mary 150 times. Soon a mystery of Jesus' life was attached to each Hail Mary. Though Our Lady's giving the rosary to Saint Dominic is recognized as a legend, the development of this prayer form owes much to the Dominicans. One of them, Alan de la Roche, known as "the apostle of the rosary," founded the first Confraternity of the Rosary in the 15th century. In the 16th century, the rosary evolved to its present form—with 15 mysteries (Joyful, Sorrowful, and Glorious). In 2002, Saint John Paul II added the Mysteries of Light (the Luminous Mysteries) to this devotion.

Some people, even Catholics, feel uncomfortable praying the rosary. They think that doing so violates Jesus' prohibition against repetitive prayer. But this is a mistake. When we repeat prayers in the rosary, we are not trying to gain God's attention by piling words upon words. What we are actually doing is involving our bodies in prayer so that our minds are free to meditate on the mysteries of salvation.

I encourage each of you to participate in our October Rosary Challenge. Each day help us achieve our goal of 10,000 Rosaries for the intention: For the protection and spiritual renewal of our parish family at St. Anthony and Our Lady of Mercy. Let us pray for one another.

COMUNIDAD HISPANA

ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

El 7 de octubre de 1571, las fuerzas cristianas aliadas de la Liga Santa obtuvieron una decisiva victoria naval contra las superiores fuerzas invasoras musulmanas del Imperio Otomano en la célebre batalla de Lepanto, en el golfo de Petras. Esta batalla ha sido llamada «la batalla que salvó a Occidente».

La victoria cristiana se atribuyó a la intercesión de Nuestra Señora, cuya intervención se obtuvo mediante el rezo del rosario. De vuelta a Roma, el Papa San Pío V, informado del feliz resultado de la batalla por revelación mística, instituyó el 7 de octubre como fiesta de Nuestra Señora del Rosario.

El desarrollo del rosario tiene una larga historia. Primero surgió la práctica de rezar 150 Padrenuestros a imitación de los 150 Salmos. Luego hubo una práctica paralela de rezar el Ave María 150 veces. Pronto, a cada Avemaría se asoció un misterio de la vida de Jesús. Aunque la entrega del rosario a Santo Domingo por parte de la Virgen es reconocida como una leyenda, el desarrollo de esta forma de oración debe mucho a los dominicos. Uno de ellos, Alan de la Roche, conocido como «el apóstol del rosario», fundó la primera Cofradía del Rosario en el siglo XV. En el siglo XVI, el rosario evolucionó hasta su forma actual, con 15 misterios (gozosos, dolorosos y gloriosos). En 2002, San Juan Pablo II añadió a esta devoción los Misterios de Luz (los Misterios Luminosos).

Algunas personas, incluso católicas, se sienten incómodas rezando el rosario. Piensan que hacerlo viola la prohibición de Jesús contra la oración repetitiva. Pero esto es un error. Cuando repetimos las oraciones del rosario, no estamos intentando atraer la atención de Dios amontonando palabras sobre palabras. Lo que en realidad estamos haciendo es involucrar nuestros cuerpos en la oración para que nuestras mentes estén libres para meditar en los misterios de la salvación.

Les animo a todos a participar en nuestro Reto del Rosario de octubre. Ayúdenos cada día a alcanzar nuestro objetivo de 10.000 Rosarios por la intención: Por la protección y renovación espiritual de nuestra familia parroquial en San Antonio y Nuestra Señora de la Misericordia. 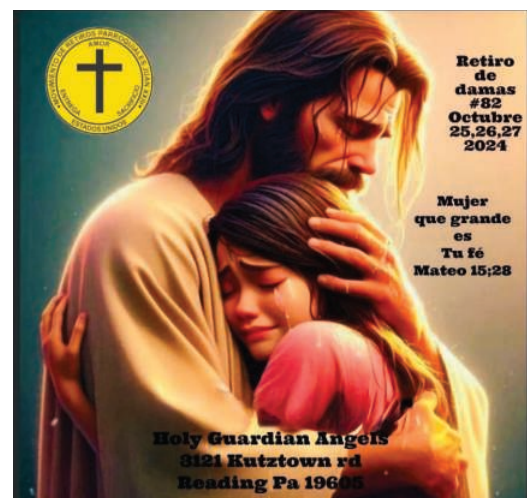
