PASTOR'S NOTES

Every Sunday we recite in the Creed, "He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead." What does this mean? When will it occur? Is the end of the world coming soon? Today's gospel points to a definitive end of the world. Yet, it is clear that we do not know the when. *"But of that day or hour, no one knows, neither the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father."* Let's look at the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* to shed some light on this truth of our faith.

"Christ is Lord of eternal life. Full right to pass definitive judgment on the works and hearts of men belongs to him as redeemer of the world. He "acquired" this right by his cross. The Father has given "all judgment to the Son." **Yet the Son did not come to judge, but to save and to give the life he has in himself.** *"By rejecting grace in this life, one already judges oneself, receive according to one's works, and can even condemn oneself for all eternity by rejecting the Spirit of love."* CCC 679

"On Judgment Day at the end of the world, Christ will come in glory to achieve the definitive triumph of good over evil which, like the wheat and the tares, have grown up together in the course of history." CCC 681

"When he comes at the end of time to judge the living and the dead, the glorious Christ will reveal the secret disposition of hearts and will render to each man according to his works and according to his acceptance or refusal of grace." CCC 682

Let me close with words from Pope Francis, "Dear brothers and sisters, **may looking at the Last Judgement never frighten us:** rather, may it impel us to live the present better. God offers us this time with mercy and patience so that we may learn every day to recognize him in the poor and in the lowly. Let us strive for goodness and be watchful in prayer and in love. May the Lord, at the end of our life and at the end of history, be able to recognize us as good and faithful servants."

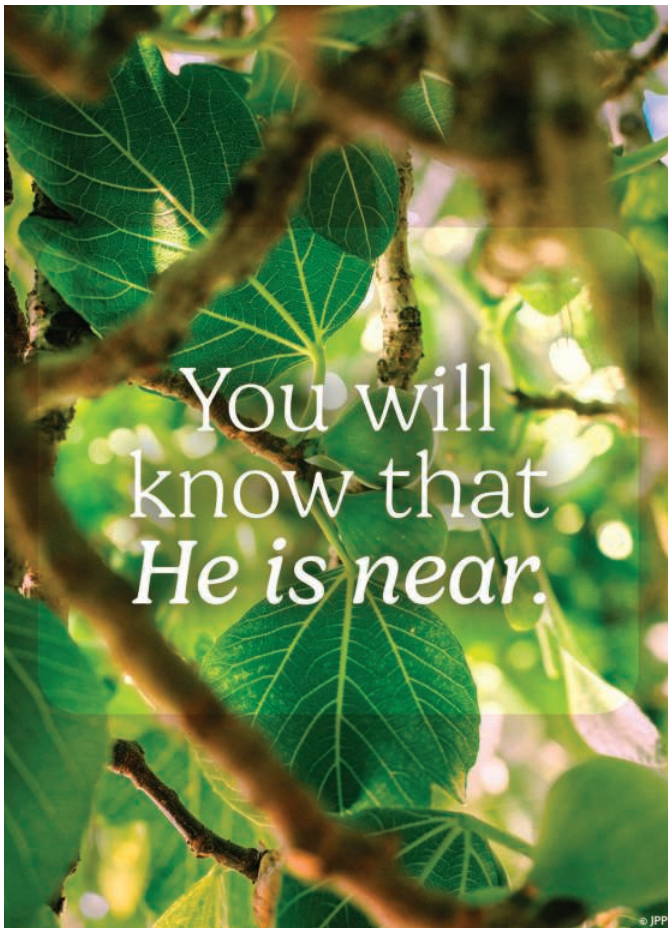

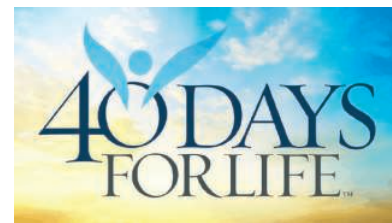

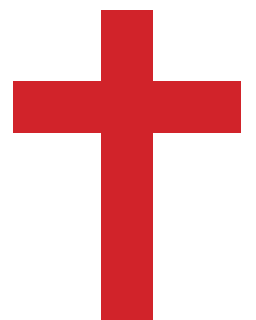
