## PASTOR'S NOTES

*"The LORD, your God, is in your midst, a mighty savior; he will rejoice over you with gladness, and renew you in his love, he will sing joyfully because of you, as one sings at festivals."*

These inspired words were spoken 600 years before Christ by the prophet Zephaniah. He was speaking to a people who were burdened with war and destruction. Their hope had been smothered. They were assaulted with discouragement. The Church selects this passage for the 3rd Sunday of Advent cycle C. The same Holy Spirit who spoke through the prophet continues to offer hope and encouragement to us. We can experience the busyness of the season, feeling behind on our preparations, mental and physical exhaustion, fear of the future, loneliness and sadness. We can experience separation from family. And we may be heavily burdened by the death of a loved one. These are all real experiences.

And yet, listen to the Word of God today. God invites us to rejoice. We make an act of faith. I believe that God is in our midst. This is a central teaching of our Catholic Faith. The Holy Eucharist is the enduring presence of Jesus Christ. The same Jesus who was in the womb of Mary, the same Jesus who preached and healed in Jerusalem, the same Jesus who died on the cross and rose three days later is present among us. Jesus is our Savior. Jesus desires to rescue us from our sadness, our hopelessness, and our fears. Jesus wants to heal us from the pain and worry we experience in our lives. Jesus wants to fill our hearts with hope. This is true! Do we believe it? Faith leads to authentic joy. Can you re-read the words of Zephaniah as if God was speaking directly to you and only you? God rejoices in you. God wants to renew you in his love. God sings joyfully because of you. WOW! Lord, help me to let these words sink into my heart, mind and soul.

One of the best ways to experience the deep peace that comes from God is making a good confession. Here is a list of opportunities to participate in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. At each location, there will be multiple priests available to listen to confessions:

# COMUNIDAD HISPANA

## ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR

El Señor será el rey de Israel en medio de ti y ya no temerás ningún mal. Aquel día dirán a Jerusalén: "No temas, Sión, que no desfallezcan tus manos. El Señor, tu Dios, tu poderoso salvador, está en medio de ti. Él se goza y se complace en ti; él te ama y se llenará de júbilo por tu causa, como en los días de fiesta"

Estas palabras inspiradas fueron pronunciadas 600 años antes de Cristo por el profeta Sofonías. Hablaba a un pueblo agobiado por la guerra y la destrucción. Su esperanza había sido sofocada. Les asaltaba el desánimo. La Iglesia elige este pasaje para el tercer domingo del ciclo C de Adviento. El mismo Espíritu Santo que habló a través del profeta sigue ofreciéndonos esperanza y aliento. Podemos experimentar el ajeteo del tiempo, el retraso en los preparativos, el agotamiento físico y mental, el miedo al futuro, la soledad y la tristeza. Podemos experimentar la separación de la familia. Y podemos estar muy agobiados por la muerte de un ser querido. Todas estas son experiencias reales.

Y, sin embargo, escucha hoy la Palabra de Dios. Dios nos invita a alegrarnos. Hacemos un acto de fe. Creo que Dios está en medio de nosotros. Esta es una enseñanza central de nuestra fe católica. La Sagrada Eucaristía es la presencia permanente de Jesucristo. El mismo Jesús que estaba en el vientre de María, el mismo Jesús que predicó y curó en Jerusalén, el mismo Jesús que murió en la cruz y resucitó tres días después está presente entre nosotros. Jesús es nuestro Salvador. Jesús desea rescatarnos de nuestra tristeza, nuestra desesperanza y nuestros miedos. Jesús quiere curarnos del dolor y la preocupación que experimentamos en nuestras vidas. Jesús quiere llenar nuestros calores de esperanza. ¡Esto es verdad! ¿Lo creemos? La fe conduce a la auténtica alegría. ¿Puedes releer las palabras de Sofonías como si Dios te hablara directamente a ti y sólo a ti? Dios se alegra por ti. Dios quiere renovarte en su amor. Dios canta alegremente por ti. ¡WOW! Señor, ayúdame a que estas palabras calen en mi corazón, en mi mente y en mi alma.

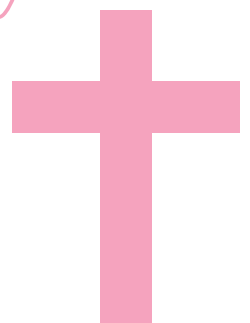
## NOTICIAS DE PREPARACION
