PASTOR'S NOTES

As we celebrate the 4th and final week of Advent, Mary is the central figure in the Gospel. There is a great spiritual principal in our Catholic faith. God the Father chose Mary to bring his Son into the world. In other words, Jesus did not just appear on earth. He came into this world through Mary. Mary gives Jesus a body. As this body is forming in the womb of Mary, she brings him to her cousin Elizabeth. Elizabeth and her baby sense the presence of Jesus in Mary. Two mothers and two babies in the womb. The Gospel tells us, 'For at the moment the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the infant in my womb leaped for joy.'

In our spiritual life, Mary has an indispensable role. Mary, full of grace, brings Jesus to people - to you and me. Just as Jesus comes into this world to us through Mary, we too must go to Jesus through Mary. The greatest desire in the heart of Mary is to assist us and to deepen our daily encounter with her Son, Jesus Christ. In this last but brief week of Advent, ask Mary to prepare your heart to celebrate the birth of her Son. Her greatest joy is for us to encounter the presence of Jesus. Give yourself the greatest spiritual gift, open your heart and allow Mary to bring you Jesus. This week, I invite you into a meditation. In your imagination, picture Mary holding the newborn baby, Jesus. Take a moment to rest in that image. Then, picture Mary inviting you to hold the newborn baby. Allow your imagination to feel and hold this treasure, this Gift from heaven. May Jesus, the Prince of Peace, touch your heart as you receive the newborn baby from the arms of Mary.

Please be assured of my prayers for you and your family this week especially as we celebrate the birth of Christ. Please see the bulletin for the Mass times for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day!

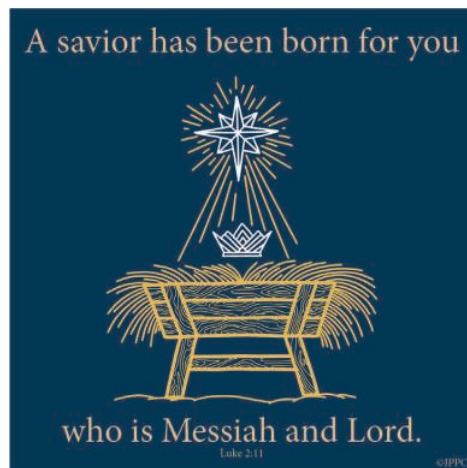
