PASTOR'S NOTES

Merry Christmas!! As members of the Church, the celebration of Christmas is more than just one day. This year the Christmas season ends on January 12th, the feast of the Baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist. This season celebrates a central mystery of our faith. We call this mystery - the Incarnation. The invisible God becomes visible. The Word becomes flesh. The infinite God reveals Himself through a human body. The humility of God reveals itself through the vulnerability of a little baby. Jesus Christ, the Son of God, enters this world through the Virgin Mary. Jesus and Mary are entrusted into the care of St. Joseph. The Son of God has become one of us. Today, we celebrate the feast of the Holy Family. As part of the Father's plan, Jesus prepared for his mission in this family. This formation prepared him for his divine mission as Savior of the World. In his family, he learned to pray. He was formed in the Jewish faith practices. He learned the responsibilities of living in a family. He did chores. He learned how to love. He learned the meaning of sacrificial love. Today's Gospel tells us that Jesus learned obedience in his family. He listened to his mother and father.

The Holy Family is a guide for all of us. The family is the place where we begin to learn the important virtues of life. In fact, the Church uses the term, "domestic Church" to describe the family. The word "obedience" means to listen. This virtue is not easy. We discover an interior rebelliousness at times within us. Learning obedience is a life-long task. We pray for this every time we pray the Our Father. "Thy will be done." "Father, help us to live as the Holy Family, united in respect and love. Bring us to the joy and peace of your eternal home."
